Final Rites Set For Mrs. Googe of Rienzi Area

Final rites for Mrs. Charlotte Walker Googe, 78-year-old resident of Rienzi, Miss., and wife of Dr. George W. Googe, well known Alcorn County physician. Services to be held Sunday at 2 p. m. at the Rienzi Methodist Church with the Rev. A. R. Beasley minister of the Rienzi Church officiating.

Interment will follow in Henry Cemetery with McPeters Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The deceased, a native of Tippah County, was a member of the Methodist Church and was married to Dr. George W. Googe on October 22, 1905 at Ripley, Miss.

Mrs. Googe died at her home (May 25, 1955) in Rienzi at 7 a. m. today after an illness of two weeks.

Survivors include: her husband Dr. G. W. Goode of Rienzi; a son, George Walker Googe, Jr. of Jackson, Tenn.; three daughters, Mrs. Louise Googe of Rienzi, Mrs. Marie G. Belser of Florence, Ala. and Mrs. Willard G. Carithers of Statesville, N.C., three grandchildren, Janeen Googe, George Morton Googe and Robert L. Carithers.
