D. Crow Sr., well-known Corinth land owner, farmer and road contractor, died suddenly of a heart attack at his home here Sunday (December 14, 1958). He was 67.

A native of Alcorn County, Crow was a 32nd Degree Mason. He had been a member of the Alcorn County Election Commission for several years, and a Sunday school teacher at Union Baptist Church for 40 years. Crow married the former Miss Ann Mattox in Alcorn County in 1913, and she survives.

Other survivors include several sons, D. Crow, Jr., J. C., William ray, Harvey, Leroy and Jack Crow, all of Corinth, and Bill crow of Memphis; three daughters, Mrs. Venice Green, Mrs. Joy Ginn and miss Ann Crow, all of Corinth; two sisters, Mrs. Florence Wilhite and Mrs. Lou Elliott, both of Corinth and nine grandchildren.

Services will be held at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from Union Baptist Church with Rev. W. A. Hamilton and Rev. Joseph Crawford officiating. Burial will be in Union Cemetery with McPeters Funeral home in charge.

Pallbearers will be C. L. Wilhite, Boyd Elliott, Roy Elliott, Vernell Wilhite, William Kuykendall, Howard Lancaster, Raymond Mattox and Junior Mattox.

Honorary Pallbearers will be the Board of Supervisors, Deacons of Union Baptist Church, and J. T. Wilbanks, W. C. Sweat and Harley Moses.
