## DILWORTH, Mrs. Abe

Funeral services for Mrs. Abe Dilworth of Rienzi, Miss., will be held tomorrow at 3 p.m. at the Hinkle Creek Baptist Church with Revs Dewey Wallis and Cleaton Wilbanks in charge of last rites.

Mrs. Dilworth, a native of Alcorn County, died this morning (March 29, 1958) at her home. She was 75 years of age and had been ill for the past eight months.

She was a widow of the late Abe Dilworth whom she married April 10, 1905. She was a member of the Baptist Church.

She leaves her son, Dr. Miller Dilworth of Jackson, Miss., seven daughters, Mrs. John Bowers, Mrs. Ward Bynum and Mrs. Max Johnson, all of Corinth, Mrs. Rex Hamilton of Glen, and Mrs. Ben Wall of Jackson, Miss., Mrs. Ronel Coleman of Kossuth, Miss., and Mrs. Edward Cleary of Tupelo, Miss., two brothers, Tom H. Miller of Rienzi, Miss., and John Hillie Miller of Booneville, Miss.; and 15 grandchildren.
