Agother deponent testifies that on Monday, about II o'clock, A. M. he met the same wayon and the same driver, whom he had seen the night before, with Grogan and four atmed British dragoons, and four more drag oous mounted, who rode near the wagon, and were on their way from Chrenceville, in Ganada, towards Mississqui Bity Village .-Col. Grogan was badly wounded, and almost entirely naked.
