Amended Report of sale of Land,

To the Honorable Probate Judge of the Probate Court of
Marshall County State of Mississippi -

Your petitioners Wilton M'Kee and William M'Kee

in and of the law of Daniel M'Kee deceased would respectfully

report to your honor that at the April term of your Honors Court they filed a report of the sale of the Real estate of Daniel M'Kee deceased, to which there is an Amended report. Your petitioners would state unto you that a portion of said land was embraced in the claim for sale and which and which was only sold under said claim was not embraced in said report to wit the South East quarter of Section four of Township five Range four west. Your petitioners would report unto your honor that on the 13th day of April when said other lands as described in said claim were sold the above described land was also taken up the law prescribes by law at the doors of the Court house in said County put up for sale at public outcry to the highest bidder on a credit of one and two years from the day of sale when and when offered B. A. Alexander who bid the sum of thirteen dollars and forty nine and one half cents per acre which being the highest and best bid therefor the same was struck off to him and he became the purchaser thereof at the aggregate sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars and twenty cents. Your petitioners would state that the said B. A. Alexander has given bond with sufficient security for the payment of the purchase money payable in one year, and during said securities sufficient in the opinion of your petitioners to defend his possession of said land to said purchaser. Your petitioners would further report that legal notice of the time and place was duly given as will appear by reference to the exhibits of said former report. Your petitioners would further state unto your honor in said former report the land described as sold to said B. A. Alexander to wit. South East quarter of Section four Township five Range four west was described as being in Range five, whereas the land really sold as will appear by the claim was range four.
