The Condition of this Obligation is such, That, whereas, application has this day been made to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County of Marshall, and State aforesaid, for the granting and issuing of License for the Marriage of *Riley Owens* and *Sophronia Sunday*, Now, therefore, if there shall be no lawful cause to obstruct the Marriage for which this License is granted, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
