 day been made to the Clerk of the J. S. Clark Court of the County of Marshall, and State aforesaid,
 for the granting and issuing of License for the Marriage of Frizzell Brown
 and Jane Watson. Now, therefore, if there shall be no lawful cause to
 obstruct the Marriage for which this License is granted, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in
 full force and effect.
