From Dennis, Mississippi, travel down Highway 4. Turn left on the gravel road past the McDougal Landing sign.

The Vaughn Cemetery was surveyed by Sadie Gist and Mary Sue Wright on July 21, 1996. This cemetery was marked by M. L. Sandy of Corinth, Mississippi. The tombstones were transcribed from TCHGS' *Tishomingo County, Mississippi Cemeteries* by Cindy Whirley Nelson. Bob and Cindy Nelson revisited the cemetery and took photographs on February 26, 2006. As evident in the photographs, many of these stones were faded and unreadable. Some stones were broken, rocks were strewn, and trees covered many of the tombstones.
