SUBJECT: 1896 PHOTOGRAPH OF DUNBAR BISLAND WADE (1843-1908) AND FAMILY MEMBERS, INCLUDING WALTER BISLAND WADE (1867-1933), AUTHOR OF A DIARY PREVIOUSLY SENT TO YOU.

We are indebted again to Mary and Carroll D. Bowman, 1301 Taft Street, Lemon Grove, California 92045 for the loan of treasured family objects which in this matter are two photographs taken circa 1896. The photos are of particular interest at this time because Walter Bisland Wade was the author of the diary, portions of which were loaned to us recently by Cousins Mary & Carroll. That manuscript was written during parts of the years between 1884 and 1891.

The original of the photograph is about 6" x 8", is almost purplishbrown in color, and is broken into two pieces length-wise. A number was written on the face of the picture for each person in it, and on the backside of the photo the number and name of each person is listed. It is not known who placed the numbers and information on the front and backside.

Here is a copy of the picture I made of the original:



On the page that follows there will be two columns of information. Under Column 1 there will appear the numbers and names as they are written on the back-side of the photograph. Under Column 2 there will appear a fuller name, taken from page 170 of the Ann Mims Wright book, "...Descendants of Isaac Ross and Jean Brown and the Allied Families...", to better identify those in the photograph. — Bear in mind that the head of this family is a descendant of Judge Isaac Ross Wade (1814—) and Catherine Dunbar () of Prospect Hill, Jefferson County, Mississippi.

A guesstimate is that the photograph was taken at "Old Rosswood". That home was once the residence of Dr. Walter Ross Wade and his first wife, Martha Taylor Wade, and became the residence many years later of their daughter Martha Reeves Wade after her marriage to Dunbar Bisland Wade.

The second picture that was loaned was copied and a copy of it will be attached to the next page. On its back-side are written five names, and it is most probable that they are offspring of Dunbar Bisland Wade and his wife Martha Reeves Wade. All appear in the larger group picture as indicated in the columnar listings above.

OBSERVATION: This pair of pictures is of personal interest to me because Walter Bisland Wade and others in the group picture were names appearing in the list of guests at the wedding of our grandparents Eugene Allison Ross and Idella Margaret Wade on September 3, 1890. - Nearly everyone pictured was also a contemporary of our parents.
