1889 Deed for Fairview School

State of Mississippi, Tishomingo County

I hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to William Smith, Henry Smith and James South, Trustees of the Fairview School and their Successors the land described as follows: Commencing or near the center of the quarter on the north line and running South 13 rods, thence East 13 rods, thence North 13 rods, thence back to starting point about 100 yards from where the old school house stood, the said land being in South E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section (20) Township (1) Range (10) E, the Said land to be used for the purpose of building a public school house as witness this my signature the 16th day of February.
