

ISOLATED CEMETERY

Burnsville, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Burnsville Isolated Cemetery was surveyed by Shorty Bonds January 10, 1997, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 27, 2005.

Location: From Burnsville travel 365 south to 265, turn right (at Berea Church of Christ). Go approximately 1.75 miles, cross railroad tracks graves are on the right side of road approximately 100 yards down railroad tracks on hill.
