## Byram Cemetery Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Byram Cemetery was surveyed by Ron Cooper and Waylon Provins for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher transcribed their survey from the Society's cemetery book on November 4, 2005.

**LOCATION:** Travel Highway 25 south to Belmont, Mississippi. Turn left at old Highway 25 across from the Belmont City Park. Drive 0.9 of a mile to County Road 16. Turn right on County Road 16 and drive to County Road 57. Turn left onto County Road 57 and drive 0.2 of a mile. Turn onto the dirt road on the right; the cemetery is approximately 500 yards down the dirt road.
