## CARR CEMETERY Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Carr Cemetery information was given by Mrs. Flora Carr Walker & Mrs. Irene Barnes for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 3, 2005.

The Carr graves are located in the Eastport Community. Take County Road 956 (Eastport Road) approximately 5 miles to intersection of County Road 410. Take County Road 259 to right. Go approximately 2.4 miles. Cemetery is in woods on left side of road behind old home place. These graves reportedly had a small house built over them for shelter. No evidence of shelter or sandstones was found.
