The **Old Clausel Hill Cemetery** is located on County Road 1475 in Prentiss County, Mississippi. Traveling Highway 365 from Burnsville, Mississippi, go south to the Prentiss County line and turn left on County Road 1475. This road circles back into Highway 365 at the junction of Highway 364; it is just about one mile in length. If you access this road via the first turn off coming west from Burnsville, the cemeteries and church are on your right, but if the access is made from the Prentiss County side, the church and cemeteries will be on your left. The Old Clausel Hill Cemetery in located on an embankment and sits off the main road. A dirt road that has been sowed with grass provides access to the cemetery and makes a circular drive. This cemetery is a big cemetery with many available lots. It is believed that there are some unmarked graves in

this cemetery as well. Many of the stones have deteriorated and are unreadable. Some gravesites are marked with funeral home markers that are no longer readable, and others are marked with stones and bricks.

The cemeteries were surveyed by Cindy Whirley Nelson on October 21, 2005.
