## **Clement Cemetery**

<u>Directions</u>: From new River Trace subdivision in the Eastport Community, access road at River Trace (currently not paved), park on side of road 100 feet past access road. Walk on right side into woods about 100 feet to broken tombstones. Only one grave is partially visible and the others are face down and he didn't want to disturb them.
