Doan T. Moss

Doan T. Moss was born in 1869, possibly in west Tennessee. He married a daughter of Dr. Penn in Humboldt, Tenn. He entered the Railway mail Service soon before or after the turn of the century. He served practically all his Government service on the Southern Railroad from Memphis to Chattanooga, Tenn., from which he retired in 1939. He served as Supervisor of roads in first district of Tishomingo County for several years before his death in 1944. His wife preceded him in death by one or two years. They were survived by two sons: Robert Moss and Ralph Moss.
