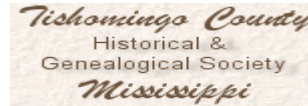

The Forked Oak Baptist Church Cemetery was initially surveyed and compiled by Alicia South (typist), Virginia Felkner South, L. A. South, and William M. South in November 1996. In November 2005, the information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher. Members of the Prentiss County Cemetery Committee re-surveyed and updated the cemetery in May 2006. The cemetery was then re-surveyed and photographed on August 12, 2006, and August 17, 2006, by Cindy Whirley Nelson and RaNae Smith Vaughn.

LOCATION: From Highway 30 at the Burton Community, travel north on Highway 365. Turn right on County Road 2312 at the sign displaying "Forked Oak Baptist Church." The cemetery, adjacent to the church, is about 0.25 of a mile from the highway. Although the Forked Oak Cemetery is located in Prentiss County, Mississippi, it is less than one mile from the Tishomingo County line; many residents of Tishomingo County are buried in the cemetery.
