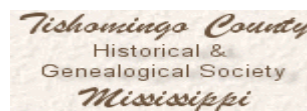

**Friendship Primitive Baptist Church
Paden, Tishomingo County, Mississippi**

Driving Directions: Travel Highway 25 North from the City of Tishomingo, Mississippi. Turn onto Highway 30 and travel west to Paden, Mississippi. At Paden, turn right, cross railroad tracks, take the second road to the right, and travel approximately 1.5 miles to the church and cemetery.

The cemetery was surveyed and photographed by Bob Nelson, Cindy Whirley Nelson, and Paulette Whirley on May 9, 2006.

There are at least 19 unmarked gravesites in this cemetery and possibly others. There are a number of unreadable tombstones as well.
