### Burnsville, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Grimes Graves were surveyed by Shorty Bonds on March 23, 1997, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 4, 2005.
