GRISSHAM AND WOODRUFF GRAVES

Paden, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Grissam and Woodruff Graves were surveyed by Bob and Cindy Nelson on June 16, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 4, 2005.

Location: From Paden, travel County Road 131 past the Wilson home place. Go about 300 yards, turn right and continue by foot toward the Tombigbee Waterway. Go to marker S6, turn left and climb embankment. This cemetery is located on the East of Berm Road.
