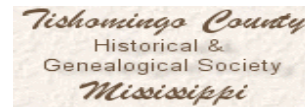

HALE CEMETRY

Belmont, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Hale Cemetery was surveyed by Bonnie Johnson on November 7, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 4, 2005.

Location: This cemetery is located across the road from the Claude Carr home place near Belmont, Mississippi

This is a family cemetery near the home of Joseph and Elizabeth Hale which contains about 20 graves. Sadly the graves are not visible anymore. Known names of people buried here are: Joseph Hale, Elizabeth Hale, Drucillia Harris (Wife of J.G. Harris), Bus Harris, an Underwood man, and some members of a Gahagan family.
