Jackson Ridge Cemetery (Alabama)

The Jackson Ridge Cemetery was surveyed by Shorty Bonds and Judy Walker on November 17, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 27, 2005.

Location: Travel Snowdown Road (CR 246) approximately three miles. Pickwick Lake will be visible from high hill, at the foot of this hill take small gravel road on the right. Gate is across gravel road. Walk past the gate approximately 400 yards, the cemetery is on the second ridge. Cemetery is located on the right side of the road on top of ridge near the lake. The front of the cemetery has a monument which is cited below. Township 3S, Range 15W, Section 21 and Margerum Alabama Quad

Many graves of blacks and whites are here. The last person buried here was Mrs. Nancy Helen Allen **Yarbrough** (03/12/1854 to 09/30/1925). She was a widow of Newton Jasper **Yarbrough** 06/16/1856 to 04/29/1909. She was buried beside him, both in unmarked graves."
