## Maness (or Manus) Cemetery Dennis, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Maness Cemetery was surveyed in 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on November 27, 2005.

Location: At Dennis take County Road 23, go approximately 0.4 of a mile. Cemetery is on right side of road in yard of a home. Stacked rocks designate cemetery.

No markers. This is known as the Maness slave cemetery, along with one white Maness (or Manus) child buried here.
