Travel Highway 25 South to Belmont, Mississippi. At the first 4-way stop sign in Belmont, turn right onto County Road 961 (Old Moore's Mill Road). Travel 4 miles to County Road 2, and turn left. Then travel 3 miles to the first gravel road, and turn right. The cemetery is located about 1 mile on the right side of the road. Section 31, Township 6, and Range 10.
