## **Paradise Methodist**

The Paradise Church is located in a rural community three miles east of Tishomingo on the old Natchez-Trace-Allsboro Road.

The land was obtained from George Ricketts for the original church, age of which can be traced back to be 150 years old, and it is believed that it might possibly be older.

On May 6, 1913, this church burned, and the present building was immediately erected. Improvements have been made such as the addition of Sunday School Annex, purchase of new pews, etc.

The present membership of the Paradise Methodist Church is 52, with five Church School Departments.
