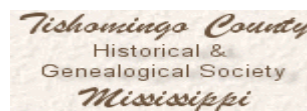

**LOCATION:** From Iuka, Mississippi, travel Highway 72 West to County Road 180. Continue left at Mt. Gilead Church onto County Road 169. Continue traveling on the same road which changes into County Road 133. At the dead end of the road, there will be a waterway gate. The cemetery is located in an wooded area at the end of the road on the right.
