RIDDLE CEMETERY Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Riddle Cemetery was surveyed by Shorty Bonds, Bobby Walker and Judy Walker on October 18, 1996, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher on December 29, 2005.

<u>Location</u>: Go Highway 365 north from Burnsville, turn left onto CR 298. Just past Shady Grove Church turn right onto CR 369(this road changes to gravel). Go 2.5 miles to a T-intersection, go right onto Cr 373. Go approximately 0.5 of a mile, take the first road on the right, go about 0.3 of a mile, and take a left at the intersection. Go 0.2 of a mile, graves are just off the road on the left. The graves have had pine trees planted over them, and are difficult to see.
