Funeral services of Mrs. Robert Cross, 54-year-old resident of Belmont, Miss., were conducted today at 2:30 p.m. at Belmont with burial in Belmont Cemetery. Deaton Funeral Home of Belmont was in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Cross, a sister of Mrs. Delbert Clay of Madison Street, Corinth, died yesterday (May 21, 1956) at Lee County Hospital in Tupelo, Miss.

Deceased was a member of the Baptist Church and was married to Robert Cross who survives. The couple had no children.
