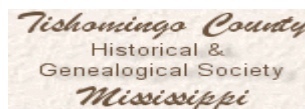

## Sharp Family Cemetery

### Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Sharp Family Cemetery information was surveyed on November 5, 1996 by Judy Walker & Shorty Bonds. The information was later transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher.

**Location:** Going south on 365 turn to the right on CR 363 for approximately 9 miles. Then go approximately three miles on Cr 373. The cemetery is located about 0.5 of a mile into woods on top of the hill. TPW 1, Range 9, Section 25 & NE ¼.
