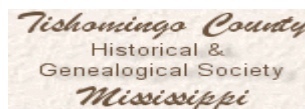

## Sharps Bottom Cemetery

### Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Sharps Bottom Cemetery was surveyed by Shorty Bonds, Bobby Walker, and Judy Walker on October 18, 1996. The information was later transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Cindy Nelson.

**Location:** From Iuka, take Highway 25 North to Highway 365, go left. Turn right onto County Road 304, go approximately one mile, then turn right onto County Road 363 and go approximately seven miles to intersection of 363 and 373. At intersection, go straight onto a gravel road (County Road 373). Go 1.5 miles (cross 2 railroad tracts) to top of hill. Park at the dirt road on the right, walk 250 feet down road. Part of a cedar fence remains on the left side of the road. Cemetery is in the woods just past the fence. There is one sandstone marker and evidence of unmarked graves. .
