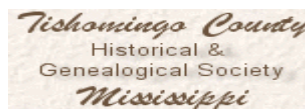

## Short Creek Cemetery

### Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Short Creek (aka Busby) Cemetery was surveyed in 1996 by Shorty Bonds . The information was later transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson & Janice Switcher on December 23, 2005.

**Location:** From Coleman Park, take CR. 308 and then turn left on CR. 323. Take the first left road for about .0.5 of a mile. NE ¼, Section 12, Township 10 and Range 10.
