SPRING HILL METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Spring Hill Cemetery was surveyed by Cindy Nelson on September 27, 1996 and October 24, 2005, for the Tishomingo County Historical & Genealogical Society. This burial information was transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Cindy Nelson in October 2005. Transcriber notes are in parentheses.

<u>Location</u>: From Iuka, take Highway 25 South approximately five miles to County Road 364 at Midway. The church and cemetery are on the right side of the road.

Spring Hill Methodist Church was organized in 1909. There were fourteen charter members: Mr. G.C. Stephens, Mr. A.W. Millsaps, Mr. J.F. Oaks, Mr. J.T. Blissit, Mr. A.W. Rost, Mr. J.E. Harp and Mr. R.A. Belue. Also, Mrs. M.A. Rutledge, Mrs. Alice Rutledge, Mrs. Ethel Millsaps, Mr. Lillie Oaks, Mrs. Amie Stephens, Mrs. Melinda Rost, and Mary Blissitt. Mrs. Mary Blissitt is now a member of Tishomingo Methodist Church. The Rev. B.P. Jace? (Pace?) was Presiding Elder, and Rev. J.R. James was pastor-in-charge.
