Stricklen Cemetery Burnsville, Tishomingo County, Mississippi

The Stricklen Cemetery was surveyed on June 6, 1996 by Bob & Cindy Nelson. The information was later transcribed from TCHGS' book entitled *Tishomingo County Mississippi Cemeteries* by Helah Wilson and Janice Switcher.

<u>Location</u>: From Highway 72 at Burnsville, take Highway 365 South to Highway 364. Turn left, then take second road to the right (County Road 137). The cemetery is on an embankment in the woods on the right side of the road. There are possibly 5 to 10 graves which are unmarked.
