### **SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TISHOMINGO COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD**

As provided for under Sections 6583 and 6630, Code of 1930 and amendments thereto, a special meeting of the Tishomingo County School Board is hereby called to be held in the office of the Superintendent of Education of the said County on Friday, October 8, 1943, at 10:00 a.m. for the following purposes:

To receive bids and award provisional contracts for the school transportation routes of the said county that have been already contracted for the 1943-44 school session. Description of the said route and equipment specifications for same are on file in the office of the Tishomingo County Superintendent of Education. Oral bids will be received, and the school Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

The County School Board will also consider at this meeting any and all matters that may be submitted to it and over which the said Board may have jurisdiction.
