Burial Today of Thomas Curtis in Tishomingo County

The following article originally appeared in *The Corinth Herald (Corinth, Miss.)*, November 5, 1903; it was transcribed (as originally written) by Cindy Whirley Nelson.)–Thursday's Daily.

Tom Curtis was buried today at a cemetery between Kendrick and Iuka, his death occurring Wednesday night. He was about 55 years of age, and lived in the Kendrick community, having gone there from near Iuka. His wife died a little more than a year ago.
