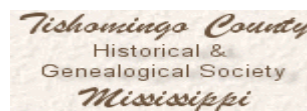

**Driving Directions:**

(1) Travel Highway 25 South to Dennis, Mississippi. Turn off Highway 4 West on County Road 1 and travel 3 miles. The cemetery is located on the left side of the road, 0.25 of a mile off of main road.

(2) From Belmont, Mississippi, travel south to Red Bud Road and turn right. At the end of this road, turn right onto County Road 1. The church and cemetery are located on the first road to the right.
