- 3. Was killed during the Civil War or died in hospital in Bowling Green, Kentucky, His remains were reported to have been brought back to this cemetery and buried next to his father "Hawkins" Holder.
- 4. He was pastor of Mount Gilead. His remains have been moved to Mount Gilead Cemetery
